

Yucai Afterschool Program

Introduction

Yucai Afterschool Program is intended to provide students an opportunity to use Chinese every day (4 days/week). Students can also participate in enrichment classes (e.g., drawing, chess, martial arts, theater, and Latin dance). Yucai Afterschool provides Friday care as well. As a result, students can immerse themselves in Chinese every day as well as develop their interests in extracurricular activities.

Curriculum

Yucai Afterschool Program offers five levels of Chinese class. **Meizhou** Chinese is the text book we use:

- Level 1 Meizhou Chinese pre-K & book 1
- Level 2 Meizhou Chinese book 2
- Level 3 Meizhou Chinese book 3
- Level 4 Meizhou Chinese book 4
- Level 5 Meizhou Chinese book 5

- Enrichment class:** 4:20-5:20pm, Mon. to Thu.
- Friday care:** 2:30-5:20pm, Friday only

Yucai After-School Registration Frequently Asked Questions

1. What does it take to register?

Step One: Fill out an online registration on Yucai school website

Step Two: Print out the summary page. The summary page appears once you click on “submit” on the registration page.

Step Three: Mail the registration summary page, the \$300.00 non-refundable deposit per student (check only), and other necessary paperwork (e.g., IEP, sibling statement, & payment plan request) to the following address.

2. What payment plan does Yucai offer?

Families who have financial hardships and cannot pay the tuition in a lump sum is eligible to use the payment plan. The payment plan may vary. We foresee two installments, fall and spring.

3. When is the tuition due?

The full tuition is due September 1st.

4. Is there a late pick-up policy?

Yes. The Chinese section ends at 4:10pm. Late fees, \$1.00 per minute, start to accrue after 4:20pm. The enrichment section ends at 5:20pm. Late fees, \$1.00 per minute, start to accrue after 5:30pm. In addition, \$100.00 per student refundable deposit is collected at the time of tuition payment for late pick-ups and other unforeseeable expense. This deposit is refunded at the end of the school year minus deductions if accessed.

5. Is there a refund if a family decides to withdraw after fully registered?

Yes. The full tuition (excluding \$300 deposit) can be refunded when a written cancellation request is received by September 1st. 50% tuition (excluding \$100 cancellation fee) can be refund for the spring semester when a written cancellation request is received by December 1. Tuition is non-refundable after December 1st.
